Amend the bill in section 2 in the blocked paragraph in the last line (page 1, line 12 in LD) by inserting after the following "1" the following 'For purposes of this subsection, "resident" means a person who resides in the State Prison'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 2 the following

'Sec. 3. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes Highway Fund allocations of \$106,739 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$109,941 in fiscal year 2024-25 to the Department of Secretary of State to increase the hourly wage paid to residents of the Maine State Prison for manufacturing vehicle registration plates to the minimum hourly wage. The current hourly wage is \$5.50 per hour.
