1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1834 is enacted to read:
3	§1834. Silent bed alarms
4 5 6 7 8	All licensed nursing facilities shall provide silent bed alarms that directly signal nursing home staff to residents who have dementia and are unable to use a call button if they fall out of a bed or chair. The department shall adopt rules to implement this section. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
9	SUMMARY
10	This bill requires all licensed nursing facilities to prevent injury or death by providing
11	silent bed alarms that directly signal nursing home staff to residents who have dementia
12	and are unable to use a call button if they fall out of a bed or chair. The bill also directs the
13	Department of Health and Human Services to adopt rules to implement this provision.
