Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, at the close of the fiscal 13 year ending June 30, 2025, as the next priority after the transfers authorized pursuant to the 14 Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, sections 1507 and 1511, the transfer of \$2,500,000 for the 15 Reserve for General Fund Operating Capital pursuant to Title 5, section 1536 and the 16 transfers to the Retiree Health Insurance Internal Service Fund pursuant to Title 5, section 17 1519 and after all required deductions of appropriations, budgeted financial commitments 18 and adjustments considered necessary by the State Controller have been made and after all 19 other transfers from the available balance of the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund 20 provided for in any other provision of law, the State Controller shall transfer from the 21 available balance of the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund up to \$18,000,000 to 22 the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Parks - General Operations 23 program, Other Special Revenue Funds account to be used for the ongoing maintenance, 24 preservation and promotion of historic sites.' 25 Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or 26 section number to read consecutively. SUMMARY 27 28 This amendment removes from Committee Amendment "A" the appropriations and 29 allocations section that provides \$1,000,000 per year in ongoing appropriations to fund the 30 ongoing maintenance, preservation and promotion of historic sites and instead requires the 31 State Controller, as the next priority transfer at the close of fiscal year 2024-25 only, after 32 all transfers are made pursuant to statute and any other provision of law, to transfer from 33 the available balance of the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund up to \$18,000,000 34 to the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Parks - General Operations

## Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$1,000,000 from the bill. It replaces them with a one-time requirement in fiscal year 2024-25 that the State Controller, as the last priority transfer after all transfers are made pursuant to statute, transfer from the available balance of the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund, up to \$18,000,000 to the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry, Other Special Revenue Funds account within the Parks - General Operations program, to be used for the ongoing maintenance preservation and promotion of historic sites.
