#### 3 SUMMARY

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This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

This bill would create a fund to reimburse school administrative units that pay tuition to state-approved schools after the October student counts are taken by the Department of Education. The bill would require that school administrative units that enroll tuition students in state-approved schools receive subsidy allocations that reflect actual tuition rates paid to the state-approved schools. The bill would require adjustments to state subsidies to be made at the end of the school year to fund students that enroll in a state-approved school after the October enrollment deadline.
