An Act to Allow Regional School Units with School Choice to Opt Out of School Choice

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §1479, sub-§6** is enacted to read:

3 **6. School choice opt-out.** A regional school unit operating under a plan described in
4 section 1461, subsection 3 where some but not all of the students are attending the schools
5 of the regional school unit may hold a referendum to amend the reorganization plan to
6 remove any school choice provisions expressly allowing students to attend a school other
7 than the school or schools operated by the regional school unit. The revised plan must
8 include a transition period for students exercising the school choice option at the time of
9 the referendum. The municipal officers of each municipality of the regional school unit
10 shall place a warrant article substantially as follows on the ballot of a municipal referendum
11 conducted in accordance with the referendum procedures applicable to the regional school
12 unit of which the municipality is a member.

13 "Article: Do you favor approving the regional school unit reorganization plan

16 **SUMMARY**

17 This bill allows a regional school unit whose reorganization plan includes school
18 choice for grade levels that had school choice in the prior school administrative units to
19 hold a community referendum to amend the reorganization plan to opt out of the school
20 choice provisions. The amended plan must include a transition period for students who are
21 exercising the school choice option at the time of the referendum.
