HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to HP 517, L.D. 828, "An Act to Ban the Drug Tianeptine"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'An Act to Ban the Sale of the Drug Tianeptine'

Amend the bill in the 4th paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 5 in L.D) by inserting after the following "the" the following 'sale of the'

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following

'Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1127 is enacted to read

§1127. Sale of tianeptine

A person may not sell or offer for sale to any other person tianeptine. Violation of this section is a Class E crime.'

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 2 and 3

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

This amendment replaces the provisions of the bill. The amendment makes the sale of tianeptine a Class E crime
