The eligible institution shall grant full credit to any student who successfully completes a course at the any eligible institution under this chapter or who successfully completes a course for college credit while enrolled as a secondary school student. The course must apply to graduation requirements at the eligible institution in which it was taken or be transferable to another eligible institution on an equal basis with a course taken by any other student at the eligible institution.

11 12 13 This bill requires an eligible institution of higher education to grant full credit to a secondary school student who successfully completes a postsecondary course at an eligible institution of higher education.
