1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3174-KKK** is enacted to read:

3 **§3174-KKK. Reimbursement for treatment of personality disorder and emotional**
4 **dysregulation**

5 Beginning January 1, 2024, the department shall reimburse under the MaineCare
6 program for the treatment of personality disorder and emotional dysregulation. The
7 department shall establish a bundled reimbursement rate for the treatment of MaineCare
8 members diagnosed with personality disorder or emotional dysregulation. In establishing
9 the bundled reimbursement rate, the department shall consider various bundled
10 reimbursement rate structures, including a daily rate and a monthly rate. The bundled
11 reimbursement rate must include participation in a dialectical behavior therapy intensive
12 outpatient program, psychiatry services, nursing services, case management, residential
13 services, after-hours skills coaching and supported employment services.

14 **SUMMARY**

15 This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services, beginning January 1,
16 2024, to reimburse under the MaineCare program for the treatment of personality disorder
17 and emotional dysregulation. The bill also requires the department to establish a bundled
18 reimbursement rate for the treatment of MaineCare members diagnosed with personality
19 disorder or emotional dysregulation.
