16 17	of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy shall conduct a study and develop recommendations regarding the implementation at the academy of a program to provide
18	trauma-informed training for law enforcement officers In conducting the study and
19	developing recommendations based on findings from the study, the board shall consult with
20	behavioral health providers and with other persons and organizations with experience and
21	expertise in trauma-informed training as necessary No later than February 15, 2024, the
22 23	board shall submit a report containing the findings and recommendations of its study, including any proposed legislation, to the Joint Standing Committee on Criminal Justice

26	As used in this section, "trauma-informed training" means training to recognize the
27	presence of trauma symptoms and to acknowledge the role that trauma can play in people's
