University of Maine System study; course regarding manufactured 2 wood products. Resolved: That the University of Maine System shall study the 3 development of a course for midcareer architects and engineers on incorporating 4 manufactured wood products into their work. In conducting the study, the University of 5 Maine System shall examine the market demand for manufactured wood products and other 6 climate-friendly building materials and pertinent midcareer training that already exists for 7 architects and engineers.

8 **Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That, by December 6, 2023, the University of Maine 9 System shall submit a report based on its study in section 1, including a description of the 10 proposed course, for presentation to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.
