COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 550, LD 884, "Resolve, to Study the
Creation of a State Employee and Legislative Child Care Center"

Amend the resolve by striking out everything after the title and inserting the following

Sec. 1. Creation of state employee and legislative child care center.

13

Resolved: That, no later than October 1, 2024, the Department of Administrative and
Financial Services shall conduct a study, within existing resources, on the creation of a
state employee and legislative child care center. The department shall study practical
matters inherent to creating the child care center, including proximity to the State House,
whether to build a new facility or repurpose an existing facility, the time period for opening
the child care center and credits or stipends to pay for child care and staffing requirements.
As part of the study, the department shall conduct a survey of state employees and
Legislators to determine potential use of the child care center. The department shall submit
a report with findings and recommendations to the Joint Standing Committee on State and
Local Government no later than October 1, 2024.
