SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 555,  
L D 899, "An Act to Authorize Vaccine Administration by Pharmacy Technicians and  
Reduce Vaccine Administration Training Requirements for Pharmacists"

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13834 in subsection 1 in the 4th line (page 2,  
line 28 in amendment) by striking out the following "drugs and" and inserting the  
following '~~drugs and~~'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13834 in subsection 1 in the 6th line (page 2,  
line 30 in amendment) by inserting after the following "or" the following 'may delegate  
the authority to administer drugs and vaccines'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13834 in subsection 2 in the first line (page 2,  
line 33 in amendment) by inserting after the following "**drugs**" the following 'or vaccines'

Amend the amendment in section 3 in §13834 in subsection 2 in the 4th line (page 2,  
line 36 in amendment) by striking out the following "drugs or"

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the changes in the authority for a pharmacy technician  
apply only to the administration of vaccines
