COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 393, LD 922, "An Act to Clarify Required Disclosure of Personally Identifying Information for Certain Nominating Petitions"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 5 in LD) by striking out the following "place" and inserting the following 'place municipality'

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 5 to 7 in LD) by striking out the following ", except that a petition for a federal office must contain the candidate's municipality of residence and is not required to contain the candidate's place of residence"

Amend the bill in section 2 in subsection 3 in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 21 and 22 in LD) by striking out the following "for a federal office"

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 26 in LD) by striking out the following "place" and inserting the following 'place municipality'

Amend the bill in section 3 in subsection 1 in the 2nd, 3rd and 4th lines (page 1, lines 26 to 28 in LD) by striking out the following ", except that a petition for a federal office must contain the candidate's municipality of residence and is not required to contain the candidate's place of residence"

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 3 in the 12th line (page 2, line 12 in LD) by striking out the following "for a federal office"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, requires a candidate, on primary petitions and nonparty nomination petitions, to provide a municipality of residence and removes the requirement to provide a place of residence. The amendment
