1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 24-A MRSA §4320-M, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 274, §5, is amended to read:
4 5 7 8 9 10	2. Limits; deductible; copayment; coinsurance. A health plan that provides coverage for the services required by this section may contain provisions for maximum benefits and coinsurance and reasonable limitations, deductibles and exclusions to the extent that these provisions are not inconsistent with the requirements of this section. A health plan with an effective date on or after January 1, 2024 may not impose any deductible, copayment, coinsurance or other cost-sharing requirement for the costs of abortion services.
