COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 590, L D 943, "An Act to Enhance Privacy and Prohibit Shipping Companies from Maintaining Records of Firearm and Ammunition Shipments"

Amend the bill in section 1 in §2015 in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 5 in L D) by inserting after the following "contrary," the following 'except as necessary for the purpose of tracking lost shipments containing firearms.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, amends the bill by adding provisions allowing a common carrier or contract carrier for transportation or shipment to keep a record, registry or database that contains sufficient information to establish a connection between any specific sender or receiver of a shipment in this State containing a firearm or firearm ammunition when done so for the purpose of tracking lost shipments containing firearms
