4 5 6 7 8	13. Certain automobiles, <u>Automobiles and</u> commercial vehicles <u>and vehicles more than 25 years old</u> . Automobiles and all over-the-road commercial vehicles with a model year prior to 1995, except when the Secretary of State determines it is in the best interest of the State and the applicant to issue a title to a vehicle with a model year prior to 1995 more than 25 years old;
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12	Current law provides that vehicles with a model year prior to 1995 are not required to have a certificate of title. This bill includes under this exemption all vehicles more than 25 years old, which is the same standard as antique automobiles.
