2	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA c. 4 is enacted to read:
3	CHAPTER 4
4	REQUIREMENTS FOR LEGISLATION
5	§101. Emergency bills
6 7	A bill submitted to the Legislature and designated as an emergency may contain only a single subject, which must relate to the cause for the emergency designation.
8	§102. Bill titles
9 10 11	The title of a bill submitted to the Legislature must accurately reflect the action performed by the bill and may not contain editorial, persuasive or misleading words or phrases.
12	SUMMARY
13 14 15 16	This bill requires that a bill submitted to the Legislature and designated as an emergency contain only a single subject related to the emergency and that the title of a bill submitted to the Legislature accurately reflect the action performed by the bill and not contain editorial, persuasive or misleading words or phrases.
