SENATE AMENDMENT "4" to S.P. 400, L.D. 981, "An Act to Require All  
Emergency Medical Services Persons to Be Trained in the Dispensing of Naloxone  
Hydrochloride"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act to Require All Emergency Medical Services Persons to Be Trained to  
Administer and Dispense Naloxone Hydrochloride'**

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

**'Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §85, sub-§8,** as enacted by PL 2021, c. 161, §4, is amended to  
read:

**8. Naloxone hydrochloride.** An emergency medical services person licensed under  
this chapter ~~may shall administer and~~ dispense naloxone hydrochloride in ~~accordance with~~  
~~Title 22, section 2353, subsection 2-A and the rules adopted and~~ compliance with protocols  
and training developed for emergency medical services persons under in accordance with  
this chapter.


**Sec. 2. Effective date.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2024.'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section  
number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment requires, beginning July 1, 2024, an emergency medical services  
person to administer and dispense naloxone hydrochloride in compliance with protocols  
and training.
