2 3	<b>Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §85, sub-§8,</b> as enacted by PL 2021, c. 161, §4, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7 8 9	<b>8. Naloxone hydrochloride.</b> An emergency medical services person licensed under this chapter may dispense naloxone hydrochloride in accordance with Title 22, section 2353, subsection 2-A and the rules adopted and protocols developed for emergency medical services persons under this chapter. An emergency medical services person licensed under this chapter must be trained to dispense naloxone hydrochloride pursuant to protocols developed in accordance with section 88-B, subsection 1, paragraph A.

11 12	This bill requires an emergency medical services person to be trained to dispense naloxone hydrochloride.
