COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to S P 408, L D 989, "Resolve, Directing the University of Maine System to Study the Potential Effects of the State's Adopting Atlantic Standard Time"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following

**'Resolve, Directing the University of Maine System to Study the Potential Effects of the State's Adopting Permanent Eastern Standard Time or Permanent Eastern Daylight Time'**

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following

**'Sec. 1. Permanent Eastern Standard Time or permanent Eastern Daylight Time study and analysis. Resolved:** That the University of Maine System shall study and analyze the potential effects on public health and the State's economy of the State's adopting permanent Eastern Standard Time or permanent Eastern Daylight Time and determine if each adoption will serve the convenience of commerce as required by the United States Department of Transportation In conducting the study, the University of Maine System shall examine

1 The current effects of the practice of setting clocks forward and backward, including but not limited to physical health, mental health and economic effects as determined by both scientific research and public opinion, and

2 Whether adopting permanent Eastern Standard Time or permanent Eastern Daylight Time will negatively affect businesses' shipping and receiving of goods and products, the ability of residents to receive important television and radio broadcasts and timely news and information, bus, passenger rail and airline services across time zones, energy availability and cost, residents who engage in work, education, recreation, health care or religious worship outside of the State's time zone, major elements of the State's economy, and any current federal, state or local plans for economic development '

Amend the resolve in section 2 in the first line (page 1, line 20 in L D ) by striking out the following "December 6, 2023" and inserting the following 'February 1, 2024'

17 This amendment changes the study focus to be conducted by the University of Maine  
18 System from the potential effects of the State's adopting permanent Atlantic Standard Time  
19 to the potential effects of the State's adopting permanent Eastern Standard Time or  
20 permanent Eastern Daylight Time It removes the requirement that the University of Maine  
21 System complete the work through private donations It changes the due date of the report  
22 to February 1, 2024 The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section
