1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 26 MRSA §843, sub-§4, ¶D, as amended by PL 2021, c. 189, §1, is further amended to read: 3 4 D. A child, domestic partner's child, grandchild, domestic partner's grandchild, parent, 5 grandparent, great-grandparent, domestic partner, sibling or spouse with a serious health condition, whether related to the employee by blood, adoption, legal custody, 6 marriage or domestic partnership; 7 8 **SUMMARY** 9 This bill adds grandparents and great-grandparents with a serious health condition to 10 the list of persons related to an employee for whom family medical leave may be taken. It also provides that an employee may take family medical leave for any of the persons listed 11 with a serious health condition who are related to the employee by blood, adoption, legal 12 13 custody, marriage or domestic partnership.
