9 an Amendment to the Constitution of Maine Regarding the Timing of Judicial Review of
10 the Determination of the Validity of Written Petitions"

Amend the resolution in that part designated "Section 22." in the 8th line (page 1,
12 line 12 in L D) by inserting after the following "100" the following 'business'

13

Amend the resolution in that part designated "Section 22." in the last 2 lines (page 1,
14 lines 12 and 13 in L D) by striking out the following "~~date of deadline for~~" and inserting
15 the following 'date of'

16

Amend the resolution in that part designated "Section 22." in the last line (page 1,
17 line 13 in L D) by inserting after the following "State" the following 'except that, if a
18 petition is filed within 30 calendar days before or after a general election, the judicial
19 review must be completed within 100 business days after the 30th calendar day following
20 that general election'

Amend the resolution in the question in the 31d line (page 1, line 22 in L D.) by striking
22 out the following "days from the deadline for" and inserting the following 'business days
23 from the date of'

Amend the resolution in the question in the last line (page 1, line 23 in L D.) by
25 inserting after the following "State" the following 'with an exception for petitions filed
26 within 30 calendar days before or after a general election'

Amend the resolution by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
28 section number to read consecutively

This amendment further proposes to amend the Constitution of Maine to provide that
31 judicial review of a determination of the validity of a written petition occur within 100
32 business days from the date of filing unless the petition is filed within 30 calendar days
