This amendment strikes and replaces the bill, which is a concept draft. The amendment provides ongoing funding for operational costs associated with arthropod management research, education and outreach within the University of Maine Cooperative Extension Diagnostic and Research Laboratory. The amendment also requires the University of Maine Cooperative Extension Diagnostic and Research Laboratory to submit a report regarding the use of the funds to the Joint Standing Committee on Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry.
