The Commissioner of Public Safety shall adopt jules requiring 18 19 training on administration and dispensing of naloxone hydrochloride by law enforcement officers who perform duties as uniformed patrol officers and requiring such officers to carry 20 21 naloxone hydrochloride while on duty Rules adopted pursuant to this subsection are 22 routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A' 23 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 24 number to read consecutively 25 **SUMMARY** 26 This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, replaces the bill and 27 changes the title It requires the Commissioner of Public Safety to adopt routine technical 28 rules requiring training on the use and administration of naloxone hydrochloride for all law 29 enforcement officers who perform duties as uniformed patiol officers and requiring such 30 officers to carry naloxone hydrochloride while on duty
