COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 435, L D 1066, "An Act to Allow a Restaurant to Serve a Bottle of Wine to the Person Who Brought the Bottle"

Amend the bill in section 4 in subsection 10 in the 6th line (page 1, line 19 in L D) by inserting after the following "\$100" the following 'per bottle'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, sets the fee charged by a restaurant, Class A restaurant or Class A restaurant/lounge for giving, serving or permitting to be served a bottle of wine furnished by a person at no more than \$100 per bottle, rather than no more than \$100 total
