1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 34-A MRS §1001, sub-§17-A** is enacted to read:

3 **17-A. Solitary confinement.** "Solitary confinement" means the isolation of a client
4 from the general population of the jail or correctional facility where the client is detained
5 by confinement in a cell or other place for 22 hours or more within a 24-hour period.

6 **SUMMARY**

7 This bill defines "solitary confinement" as the isolation of a client from the general
8 population of the jail or correctional facility where the client is detained by confinement in
9 a cell or other place for 22 hours or more within a 24-hour period.
