SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 687,
LD 1092, "An Act to Expand Services for Women Who Experience Gender-based
Trauma and Violence"

Amend the amendment by striking out the title and substituting the following

**'Resolve, To Establish an Ad Hoc Committee to Address the Commercial Sexual
Exploitation of Children'**

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the 2nd instructional paragraph
and inserting the following

'Sec. 1. Ad hoc committee establishment required. Resolved: That, no later
than November 1, 2023, the Department of Health and Human Services shall establish an
ad hoc committee The ad hoc committee shall make recommendations addressing the
intervention in and prevention of commercial sexual exploitation of children For the
purposes of this section, "commercial sexual exploitation of children" means any activity
involving the sexual abuse or sexual exploitation of a child for the financial benefit of any
person or in exchange for anything of monetary or nonmonetary value given or received
by any person The ad hoc committee must include representatives of the department, child
advocacy centers, community-based agencies with expertise working with commercially
sexually exploited children and a statewide coalition of sexual assault centers By January
1, 2025, the department shall submit a report to the joint standing committee of the
Legislature having jurisdiction over health and human services matters with any
recommendations from the ad hoc committee '

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill with a resolve and requires the Department of Health
and Human Services to establish an ad hoc committee to make recommendations
