1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15909, sub-§5, as amended by PL 2013, c. 167, Pt. B, §6, is
3	further amended to read:
4	5. Records. All records for a school construction project must be kept for 7 years after
5	the final compliance review. Each year, by January 15th, the school administrative unit
6	shall produce and make available to the public an accounting of the use of proceeds of any
7	school construction bonds issued under this section.
8	Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §15909, sub-§7 is enacted to read:
9	7. Return of unused funds. A school administrative unit shall account for and return
10	to each municipality responsible for the debt, pro rata to each municipality's responsibility,
11	the amount of any bond proceeds not used to complete the school construction project.

12	SUMMARY
13	This bill requires a school administrative unit to produce and make available to the
14	public an annual accounting of the use of school construction bond proceeds. It also
15	requires a school administrative unit to account for and return to each municipality
16	responsible for the debt the amount of any bond proceeds not used to complete the school
17	construction project.
