Resolve, to Rename Bridges in the Town of Cornish

Reference to the Committee on Transportation suggested and ordered printed.

- **Sec. 1. Sokokis Trail bridge in Cornish renamed. Resolved:** That the Department of Transportation shall designate Bridge 3859 on Sokokis Trail in the Town of Cornish, which crosses the Little River and is currently known as the Route 5/Little River Bridge, the Harriet Tubman Memorial Bridge.
- **Sec. 2. Main Street bridge in Cornish renamed. Resolved:** That the Department of Transportation shall designate Bridge 3024 on Main Street in the Town of Cornish, which crosses Douglas Brook and is currently known as the Tannery Bridge, the 9/11 Memorial Bridge.
- **Sec. 3. Depot Road bridge in Cornish renamed. Resolved:** That the Department of Transportation shall designate Bridge 3025 on Depot Road in the Town of Cornish, which crosses the Saco River and is currently known as the Depot Bridge, the Veterans Memorial Bridge.

 This resolve directs the Department of Transportation to designate Bridge 3859 over the Little River in the Town of Cornish the Harriet Tubman Memorial Bridge, Bridge 3024 over Douglas Brook in the Town of Cornish the 9/11 Memorial Bridge and Bridge 3025 over the Saco River in the Town of Cornish the Veterans Memorial Bridge.
