Resolved:** That the Office of Policy Innovation and the Future shall increase to \$100,000 the maximum community action grant amount that a project of a single community may receive. For the purposes of this section, "community action grant" means a grant to support projects that reduce energy use and costs or make the community more resilient to climate change effects, such as flooding, extreme weather, drought and public health impacts.

8 This resolve directs the Office of Policy Innovation and the Future to increase to 9 \$100,000 the maximum community action grant amount that a project of a single 10 community may receive.
