This bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations totaling \$178,750 per year beginning in fiscal year 2023-24 to Maine Maritime Academy to support a workforce development scholarship program to assist students in earning the initial credits necessary to work for a state, municipal, private or quasi-public ferry service operator located in and serving residents of the State Of this amount, \$143,750 per year is appropriated for scholarships and \$35,000 per year is appropriated for the marketing of the scholarship program
