2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §10016 is enacted to read:
3	§10016. Certain vaccines not required
4	The University of Maine System, the Maine Community College System and the
5	Maine Maritime Academy may not require as a condition of acceptance or attendance that
6	a student be immunized with a vaccine that is approved by the federal Food and Drug
7	Administration under emergency use authorization.
