SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 733,  
L.D. 1161, "An Act to Fund Free Health Clinics"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:

**Sec. 1. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF  
Maine Center for Disease Control and Prevention 0143**

Initiative: Provides one-time funding for the State's free health clinics, which are health care facilities or programs designed to provide primary medical care to medically underserved populations, particularly those who are uninsured or who have high deductible insurance plans. The funding is to be distributed based on a formula adopted by the Department of Health and Human Services using the number of clients served and a base amount for each clinic.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The amendment removes the one-time General Fund appropriation to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$250,000 in fiscal year 2023-24, but the \$250,000 in fiscal year 2024-25 remains in the bill.
