1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §3110 is enacted to read:
3	§3110. Limitation on charges
4 5 6 7 8 9	A transmission and distribution utility may not charge a customer or demand, collect or receive from a customer for any transmission and distribution utility service performed by it within the State, or for any service in connection with that performance, a compensation that is not reviewed and approved by the commission. The commission may not approve any charge or fee related to metering that is not uniform for all persons taking service in the same rate class.
10	SUMMARY
11 12 13 14 15	This bill clarifies that all charges and fees collected by a transmission and distribution utility from its customers must be reviewed and approved by the Public Utilities Commission. It also provides that the commission may not approve any charge related to metering that is not uniform for all persons taking service in the same rate class, thereby prohibiting customer-specific metering charges, such as a maintenance fee for a customer
