COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 757, L D 1197, "An Act to Prevent Coerced Abortion"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following  
'An Act to Fully Inform Pregnant Persons of Their Rights'

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §4567 is enacted to read

§4567. Rights of pregnant persons

1. Commission to produce poster or notice. The commission shall produce posters or notices in electronic or printed form.

A. Outlining this Act's protections against discrimination on the basis of pregnancy and familial status in employment, housing, access to public accommodations, fair credit extension and educational opportunity.

B. Explaining that Title 17-A, section 209 prohibits criminal threatening of any person, including a person who refuses to or chooses not to have an abortion.

C. Providing contact information for providers of resources to survivors of domestic violence, including the telephone number of at least one domestic violence hotline and at least one sexual assault hotline.

D. Informing a health care professional's patient that the patient may request that the health care professional refer the patient to law enforcement agencies and domestic violence and sexual assault survivor support organizations, including by calling law enforcement if the patient believes that the patient's safety will be at risk if the patient refuses to or chooses not to have an abortion, and

E. Informing a patient seeking an abortion that the patient has a right to withhold or withdraw the patient's consent for the abortion and receive a refund of any payments made for the abortion at any time before the abortion is performed and that, pursuant

2 the patient's right to receive public assistance or public health services or to access any  
3 other public benefit

4 **2. Commission to furnish poster or notice.** The commission shall make the posters  
5 or notices prepared under subsection 1 available, upon request, to health care professionals  
6 that provide abortions and to health care facilities where abortions are performed

7 **Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §1597-A, sub-§3, ¶C** is enacted to read

8 C A health care professional shall refund any payments received for the performance  
9 of the abortion if the minor withdraws consent to the abortion at any time prior to the  
10 abortion being performed

11 **Sec. 3. 22 MRSA §1599-A, sub-§3** is enacted to read

12 **3. Refund if consent withdrawn.** A health care professional, as defined in section  
13 1596, subsection 1, paragraph C, shall refund any payments received for the performance  
14 of an abortion if the pregnant patient withdraws consent to the abortion at any time prior to  
15 the performance of the abortion

16 **Sec. 4. 22 MRSA §1599-A, sub-§4** is enacted to read

17 **4. Health care professional to post notice of pregnant person's rights.** A health  
18 care professional, as defined in section 1596, subsection 1, paragraph C, who performs  
19 abortions shall post and keep posted, in a place where it may be viewed by all patients of  
20 the health care professional who may seek an abortion, a copy of the poster or notice  
21 prepared by the Maine Human Rights Commission under Title 5, section 4567

22 **Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and

40 poster or notice prepared by the Maine Human Rights Commission in a place where it may

1 be viewed by all of the health care professional's patients who may seek an abortion. It  
2 also requires a health care professional to refund any payments received for the  
3 performance of an abortion if a pregnant patient withdraws consent to the abortion at any

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill provides a one-time appropriation to the Maine Human Rights Commission of \$10,000 in fiscal year 2023-24 to produce and make available to health care providers and facilities posters or notices regarding certain legal protections for pregnant persons, the rights of pregnant patients and resources for survivors of domestic violence
