Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §12535, sub-§2,** as enacted by PL 2015, c. 502, §11, is amended to read:
- **2. National standards.** A certified professional midwife shall at all times practice within the scope of practice and national standards as delineated by the national association of certified professional midwives American College of Nurse-Midwives and the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists or their successor organizations.
- **Sec. 2. 32 MRSA §12535, sub-§5,** as enacted by PL 2015, c. 502, §11, is amended to read:
- **5. Board rules.** Clarifications of The board shall adopt rules relating to the scope of practice of a certified professional midwife may be established by board rule consistent with subsection 2. Rules adopted under this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
- **Sec. 3. 32 MRSA §12537, sub-§2,** as enacted by PL 2015, c. 502, §11, is amended to read:
- **2. Standards.** A certified midwife shall at all times practice within the scope of practice and national standards as delineated by the national college of nurse midwives American College of Nurse-Midwives and the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists or their successor organizations.
- **Sec. 4. 32 MRSA §12537, sub-§5,** as enacted by PL 2015, c. 502, §11, is amended to read:
- **5. Board rules.** Clarifications of The board shall adopt rules relating to the scope of practice of a certified midwife may be established by board rule, consistent with national standards subsection 2. Rules adopted under this subsection are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.
- Sec. 5. Board of Complementary Health Care Providers to amend rules. The Board of Complementary Health Care Providers shall amend its rules adopted pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 32, section 12535, subsection 5 related to circumstances under which certified professional midwives are required to recommend and facilitate modification of the care relationship to replace the terms "collaboration" and "consultation" with "referral."

32 SUMMARY

This bill amends the national standards by which certified professional midwives and certified midwives are required to practice and changes from permissive to mandatory the rulemaking of the Board of Complementary Health Care Providers relating to the scope of practice of certified professional midwives and certified midwives and directs the board to replace the terms "collaboration" and "consultation" with "referral" in the board's rules regarding certified professional midwives.
