I	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3 4	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3173, as amended by PL 2021, c. 398, Pt. OOO, §§1 to 3 and c 423, Pt. B, §1 and corrected by RR 2021, c. 2, Pt. B, §§155 to 158, is further amended by enacting at the end a new paragraph to read:
5 6 7	Whenever a MaineCare member is determined by the department to no longer be eligible to receive benefits under this chapter, the department shall provide the member 60 days' notice that benefits will be terminated.
8	SUMMARY
9 10	This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to notify a MaineCare member 60 days prior to terminating benefits under the MaineCare program.
