13 Amend the bill in section 2 in §1600 in subsection 3 in the first line (page 1, line 23 in 14 L.D) by striking out the following "C" and inserting the following. 'D'

15 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 16 number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

18 This amendment, which is a minority report of the committee, provides that the 19 prescription of an abortion-inducing drug or device by telehealth, telephone, the Internet or 20 other type of digital communication and the shipment of an abortion-inducing drug or a 21 device by mail, express delivery service or other means of interstate commerce is a Class 22 D crime and not a Class C crime as in the bill
