1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §1614, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 2021, c. 477, §1 and reallocated by RR 2021, c. 1, Pt. A, §54, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
4 5	4. Exemptions. A product or business is exempt from certain requirements as provided by this subsection.
6	A. The following products are exempt from this section:
7 8	(1) A product for which federal law governs the presence of PFAS in the product in a manner that preempts state authority; or
9	(2) A product subject to Title 32, chapter 26-A or 26-B.
10 11	B. The following businesses are exempt from the requirement of subsection 2. paragraph A, subparagraph (3):
12	(1) A business that has fewer than 10 employees; or
13	(2) A business that has less than \$1,000,000 in annual revenue.
14	SUMMARY
15 16	This bill exempts certain businesses from the requirement to test products for perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances.
