## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

- **Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §994, sub-§11,** as amended by PL 2005, c. 104, §2, is further amended to read:
- 11. Information available to committee. To receive certain information. Information Except as provided in subsection 11-A, information that is made available to the committee is governed by chapter 21, which governs legislative investigating committees, and by Title 1, chapter 13, which governs public records and proceedings; and
  - Sec. 2. 3 MRSA §994, sub-§11-A is enacted to read:
- 11-A. Information relating to child death investigation. To receive documents from the Department of Health and Human Services relating to an investigation of the death of a child with previous department involvement, including any information in the possession of the department regarding contact or other involvement with the child. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, documents received by the committee under this subsection are confidential; and

SUMMARY

This bill provides that the Government Oversight Committee has access to documents in the possession of the Department of Health and Human Services relating to an investigation of the death of a child with previous department involvement, including any information regarding department contact or other involvement with the child, and that those documents are exempt from public disclosure.
