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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT “ A ” to S P 520, L D 1283, “Resolve, to Reestablish the Task Force to Study the Creation of a Comprehensive Career and Technical Education System”

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Amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 1 in paragraph C (page 1, line 25 in L D) by striking out the following "is on the State Board of Education" and inserting the following 'represents a statewide association of career and technical education administrators'

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Amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 3, in paragraph A (page 1, line 40 in L D) by striking out the following "an administrator at a community college" and inserting the following 'a Maine Community College System administrator'

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Amend the resolve in section 7 in the first line (page 2, line 32 in L D) by striking out the following "no later than December 6, 2023" and inserting the following 'notwithstanding Joint Rule 353, no later than January 15, 2024'

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Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

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SUMMARY

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This amendment changes the membership of the Task Force to Study the Creation of a Comprehensive Career and Technical Education System to require that one member represent a statewide association of career and technical education administrators and that one member be a Maine Community College System administrator It also changes the task force's reporting date

Legislative Cost/Study

The general operating expenses of this study are projected to be \$3,050 in fiscal year 2023-24. The Legislature's proposed budget for the 2024-2025 biennium includes \$14,500 in each of fiscal years 2023-24 and 2024-25 for the costs of legislative studies, as well as \$2,234 in projected balances from fiscal year 2022-23 and \$36,777 of balance carried over from prior years for this purpose. Whether these amounts are sufficient to fund all studies will depend on the number of studies authorized by the Legislative Council and the Legislature. The additional costs of providing staffing assistance to the study during the interim can be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted staff resources.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Additional costs to the Department of Education, the State Board of Education, the Maine Community College System and the University of Maine System associated with having representatives serve on the task force can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
