SUMMARY

 This bill terminates the Maine Information and Analysis Center, which results in a General Fund deappropriation of \$399,944 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$533,260 in fiscal year 2024-25 to the Department of Public Safety. The bill also results in a Highway Fund and Federal Expenditures Fund deallocation of \$215,319 and \$78,651, respectively, in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$287,093 and \$104,870 in fiscal year 2024-25. It also results in a Federal Expenditures Fund deallocation of \$100,000 beginning in fiscal year 2023-24 to the Department of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management.
