COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H P 821, L D 1296, "An Act to Authorize Municipalities to Allow Firefighters to Have Increased Lighting on Their Personal Vehicles"

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph F in subparagraph (2) in the 11th line (page 1, line 14 in L D) by striking out the following "from 10" and inserting the following 'no more than 12'

Amend the bill in section 1 in paragraph F in subparagraph (2) in the 11th and 12th lines (page 1, lines 14 and 15 in L D) by striking out the following "up to the width between the tops of the doors"

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

The bill changes the length of the red light bar allowed on vehicles of active members of municipal or volunteer fire departments to 10 inches up to the width between the tops of the doors This amendment changes the maximum length of the red light bar to no more than 12 inches
