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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 533, LD 1315, "An Act to Require Instruction in Schools on Substance Abuse Prevention and Administration of Naloxone Hydrochloride"

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Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following

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**'An Act to Require Public Schools to Offer Training for Secondary Students on the Administration of Naloxone Hydrochloride'**

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Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following

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**'Sec. 1. 20-A MRS §6307-A** is enacted to read

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**§6307-A. Naloxone hydrochloride administration instruction**

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In accordance with rules adopted by the department, a public school shall offer training to secondary students on how to administer naloxone hydrochloride, as defined in section 6307, subsection 1, paragraph C, in nasal spray form. The rules adopted by the department under this section must provide that the training is an extracurricular instruction, that instruction is delivered by a qualified individual and that the standards for instruction are based on those of a nationally recognized program, organization or agency. Rules adopted under this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'

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Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

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### SUMMARY

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This amendment changes the title and replaces the bill. The amendment requires a public school to offer training to secondary students on how to administer naloxone hydrochloride nasal spray. The amendment also directs the Department of Education to adopt rules that must provide that the training is an extracurricular instruction, that

### Fiscal Note

Potential State Mandate - Unfunded

#### State Mandates

##### Required Activity

Requires secondary schools to offer training to students on how to administer naloxone hydrochloride nasal spray. The training must be offered as an extracurricular activity, delivered by a qualified individual and based on the standards of a nationally recognized program, organization or agency.

##### Unit Affected

School

##### Local Cost

Moderate statewide

The required local activities in this bill may represent a state mandate pursuant to the Constitution of Maine. If the bill does require a local unit of government to expand or modify its activities so as to necessitate additional expenditures from local revenue, the state mandate provisions of the Constitution of Maine require either (1) General Fund appropriations be provided to fund at least 90% of any additional necessitated local costs of the mandate, or (2) a Mandate Preamble be added to the bill and two-thirds of the members of each House vote to exempt the mandate from the funding requirement. If the bill does represent a state mandate and neither one of these actions occurs, the local units of government will not be required to implement the mandated activities.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

Additional costs to the Department of Education associated with the rulemaking process can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
