2	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §1598, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
3 4 5	1-A. Preemption. The State intends to occupy and preempt the entire field of legislation concerning the regulation of a person's decision to terminate a pregnancy and legislation concerning the provision of abortion.
6	SUMMARY
7 8	This bill provides that the entire field of legislation concerning abortion is occupied and preempted by the State.
