12 (page 2, lines 27 to 29 in amendment) and inserting the following

14 article, is subject to requirements of article 6, article 7, article 8-A or Title 12, chapter  
15 206-A as applicable, including, but not limited to, applicable requirements and  
16 standards under those laws regarding the effect of the activity on wildlife habitat and  
17 other protected natural resources, and'

19 amendment) by inserting after the following "article 6," the following 'article 7,'

SUMMARY

23

This amendment amends Committee Amendment "A" to clarify that an activity  
24 determined by the Department of Environmental Protection to be excluded from the  
25 requirements of the Maine Metallic Mineral Mining Act and subject to the requirements of  
26 the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, chapter 3, subchapter 1, article 6 or article 8-A or  
27 Title 12, chapter 206-A, as applicable, must also be subject to applicable requirements and  
28 standards under those laws regarding the effect of the activity on wildlife habitat and other  
29 protected natural resources This amendment also clarifies that such excluded activities  
30 may, as applicable, be subject to the requirements of Title 38, chapter 3, subchapter 1,  
31 article 7 and clarifies that, if an excluded activity is subject to the requirements of article 7,  
32 it is also subject to the mining excise tax under Title 36, chapter 371
