Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill establishes 8 self-service kiosks to provide registration renewal and driver's license and nondriver identification card renewal and replacement. The bill includes Highway Fund allocations of \$728,947 in fiscal year 2023-24 and \$489,675 in fiscal year 2024-25 to the Department of Secretary of State to rent the kiosks and for technology costs
