COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S P 557, L D 1390, "An Act to Provide Self-service Motor Vehicle Services in Rural and Other Areas"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following

'An Act to Provide Self-service Motor Vehicle Services'

Amend the bill in section 1 in §160 by striking out all of the 2nd indented paragraph (page 1, lines 10 and 11 in L D)

Amend the bill by inserting after section 1 the following

'Sec. 2. Report. The Secretary of State shall investigate the various types of self-service kiosks that may provide services offered by the Department of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Motor Vehicles that are available to the State, including those self-service kiosks that are offered at no cost to the State The Secretary of State shall provide a report that includes its findings from the investigation and any recommendations, including any proposed statutory changes, to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation by January 3, 2024 The committee may report out a bill related to self-service kiosks to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

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Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively

SUMMARY

This amendment removes a provision requiring self-service kiosks providing motor vehicle services to be located in rural areas. It directs the Secretary of State to investigate the various types of self-service kiosks that provide services offered by the Department of the Secretary of State, Bureau of Motor Vehicles that are available to the State, including those self-service kiosks that are offered at no cost to the State and to provide a report that includes the findings of the investigation and any recommendations, including any proposed statutory changes, to the Joint Standing Committee on Transportation by January 3, 2024. The amendment authorizes the committee to report out a bill related to self-service kiosks that provide services offered by the Bureau of Motor Vehicles to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section and changes the title.
