1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §160 is enacted to read:
3	§160. Motor vehicle services
4 5	The Secretary of State shall establish and operate 8 self-service kiosks that provide, to the maximum extent feasible, at least the following services:
6 7	1. Vehicle registration. Vehicle registration renewal pursuant to chapter 5, subchapter 1; and
8 9	2. Licenses or identification cards. Renewal or replacement for a driver's license or nondriver identification card under chapter 11.
10 11	The Secretary of State shall locate some of the self-service kiosks in rural areas that are an inconvenient distance from offices that can provide services under this section.
12	SUMMARY
13 14 15 16	This bill requires the Secretary of State to establish and operate 8 self-service kiosks to provide vehicle registration renewals and renewals or replacements of driver's licenses or nondriver identification cards. The Secretary of State must place some of the self-service kiosks in rural areas.
