Initiative: Provides one-time funds to the Maine Indian Education school district to develop
and implement a Wabanaki-centered curriculum for Native American high school students.
The Maine Indian Education school district will administer the pilot program in
conjunction with a state-approved high school. The funds will be used for curriculum
development, staff, transportation and support services.
